The accused continued to be disruptive; swearing and being hostile to-wards staff. For that, as well as refusing to leave the kitchen he was discharged from the Life skills Program and TDA (temporarily denied access) to the Salvation Army Ottawa Booth Centre.

The accused left for a few minutes but when he returned he said he refused to be denied shelter at the facility and went upstairs to the 4th floor, despite being told doing so would result in staffs need to call the police to have him removed.

At approximately 7:50, police arrived on scene and asked the accused to leave, he refused. Police advised the accused that he was under arrest for refusing to leave when directed. Police took physical control of the accused because he was non compliant; grabbing a hold of his bedroom door frame and tensing his body trying to prevent officers from removing him.

Once in cuffs the accused was searched where a small quantity of marijuana was located on his person, he was advised of the additional charges.

Rights to counsel, cautions and 524 warning were read.

The accused was transported to central cells and held for show cause.

Rights to counsel, cautions and 524 warning were read.

The accused was transported to central cells and held for show cause.

On Wednesday 28th March 2018, at approximately 0746 hours, I Cst Jenkyn along with Cst Griffith were dispatched to 171 George St, Ottawa for an

unwanted person to be removed.

Information received that Sean VON DEHN 1973/05/06 was being disruptive with staff and subsequently asked to leave. VON DEHN refused to do and police were subsequently requested to have him removed from the premise.

A records query indicated that VON DEHN is currently wanted by Guelph Police Service for fraud and failing to appear in court (bench and first instance warrant). A first instance warrant was issued by Toronto Police for revoke of surety. Another bench warrant was issued by Toronto Police for weapons dangerous/carry concealed weapon.

At approximately 0750 hours I arrived on scene where I was met by Kimberley LOVELL. LOVELL directed police to the forth floor where they were met by another staff member, Natalie YOUNGER.

Staff explained that VON DEHN needed to be removed due to his behaviour (statement obtained). Police made their way to VON DEHN's room where they spoke with him at his door.

VON DEHN told police that he has a right to be at this facility and that he would not leave. Police explained that he has to leave for a few hours due to his behaviour. VON DEHN continued to talk over police, refusing to leave, he was subsequently advised that he was under arrest for failing to leave premise when directed (0755 hours). As I attempted to gain physical control of VON DEHN he grabbed onto his bedroom door frame. Once pulled away, he began tensing his body trying to prevent officers from placing him into cuffs, he was subsequently grounded so he could be placed into hands without further incident.

Once in cuffs VON DEHN had calmed down and was taken to my cruiser where he was searched.

Given VON DEHN warrants on file; failing to appear in court and concerns about him returning to this location and causing further issues he was transported to central cells and held for show cause.



Sean left for a few minutes but when he returned he said he refused to be denied shelter at our facility and went upstairs to the 4th floor despite being told doing so would result in our need to call the police to have him removed.

Kimberly called the police while myself and Front Line Worker Peter Proulx went upstairs to talk to Sean, and observe in case his behaviour turned violent or destructive. Sean stayed in his room but eventually opened the door and was deciding if he would leave until my boss, Jason Prevost, arrived so he could speak to him. At approximately 7:50, Kimberly came upstairs with three Ottawa Police officers who arrested Sean after he refused to leave.



Kitchen staff Keisha and Carrine asked this writer for assistance due to a client (Sean Von Dehn) being verbally aggressive towards them. This writer intervened and asked Sean what was going on while he was still getting his items together for breakfast. Sean stated that the staff was rude to him and he did not care. While attempting to get Sean's side of what happened he continued to repeat that he did not care and that he asked for a different plate of food and the kitchen staff refused to give it to him. Kitchen staff Keisha and Corrine stated that he already touched the plate and had to use the plate that was given to him. Sean then proceeded to give the kitchen staff the middle finger and proceeded to sit down and eat his food. This writer asked Sean to please leave the building because verbally abusing staff is unacceptable behavior. Sean stated that he was not going anywhere until he speaks with Jason. This writer explained that speaking with Jason was not accessible at the current moment and due to his behavior, he was not welcomed in shelter. Sean responded by telling this writer that "he doesn't fucking care". This writer gave Sean the option of leaving the premises on his own or having police escort him out. Sean told this writer to "call the fucking police because I am not going anywhere!" This writer radioed front desk for additional support. FLW Peter came downstairs and spoke with Sean, advising him to speak with Supervisor Tallie upstairs. This writer called Supervisor Tallie to update her on the kitchen staff side as well as the entire situation. This writer

Came upstairs to write the IR. Supervisor Tallie was speaking with Sean and he ended up leaving the building. Sean returned a few moments later and proceeded to go up to the 4th floor, although he was asked to leave. Sean refused.

This writer contacted OPS non-emergency at 7:41am to remove Sean from the building, as he would not leave on his own. At approximately 7:33am OPS arrived and subdued Sean upstairs on the 4th floor. It is recommended this client is TDA 24hrs. Minimum.
