1. Discrimination and Harassment:

Section 8 of the Code protects individuals from reprisal or threat of reprisal for exercising their rights or claiming protection under the Code. This can be relevant in cases where beneficiaries are afraid to speak out due to the potential for negative repercussions.

Section 9 states that no person shall infringe a right under the Code. This means that actions that violate the trust relationship and harm beneficiaries are prohibited.

ALL agents of Ontario Works plead 'ignorance' of the Trust Instrument on file, the Trustee Act of Ontario which provides legislation regarding Trusts in Ontario, and Canada's Criminal Code for willfully breaching that Trust in retaliation for exercising rights under the Code and Constitution of Canada.

They 'pretend' the Trustee Act of Ontario is not binding upon them when the legislation provided by the Trustee Act of Ontario states, 'This Act applies to ALL TRUSTS WHENEVER EXPRESSED and to ALL TRUSTEES whenever appointed.'. Sections 66-68 describe the rights, powers and immunities of the Trust Instrument, which are patently IGNORED (ignorance is no excuse for the Law) with malicious intent to cause economic harm to the Beneficiary in violation of his Trust and Spiritual convictions and beliefs (Section 11 of the Code prohibits discrimination that adversely affects individuals based on their creed, and it requires organizations to accommodate these beliefs to the point of undue hardship). When I so much as ASK about honouring My Trust, they REFUSE to answer, 'ghosting Me'.

According to Canadian Law, a Trust Instrument holds a minimum commercial value of \$5000.00 and the Beneficiary is entitled to compensation for the unlawful desecration of his Trust Instrument.

This 'pleading ignorance of the Trust' has been ongoing for six years and violates at least four other contracts Ontario Works commissioners have authorized to Honour the Trust obligations.
