I am writing in response to your complaint about Vinicius Ribeiro De Oliveira ("the Paralegal"), which the Law Society received on May 22, 2025. A review of the information provided suggests that you are self-represented in a criminal matter. You have alleged that the police and court staff, including the Paralegal who is a prosecutor, are corrupt and the proceedings against you a "fraud".

The Crown has prosecutorial discretion as to how they make out their case, including what evidence they choose to present and what arguments to make. The Law Society cannot intervene in an ongoing criminal court matter, nor is the Law Society's complaint review process an appeal process.

There are no regulatory concerns disclosed by the information provided in your complaint and the file is being closed for this reason.


**Confidentiality**
