Adrienne Curran was advised in the pre-hearing conference that the Administrator destroys documents to plead ignorance of the contracts they are breaching. Breach of contract and spoliation of documents by a Trusted government official are very serious crimes. I advised Adrienne that I believe (at the very least) that the Tribunal has a duty and obligation to advise the Administrator that the Rule of Law compels the Administrator to produce any documents on the Beneficiary's case file upon request. Adrienne Curran suggested it is perfectly normal for the Administrator to withhold documents and contracts they have Signed from the Beneficiary and Will NOT compel the Administrator to produce the contracts they are breaching. Sean advised that withholding those documents is obstruction of justice and a breach of Trust because they are using the documents to exploit the Beneficiary and evade accountability.

Sean also clearly advised Adrienne in the pre-hearing conference that he is not 'Self Represented'. An artificial legal person does not have the capacity to do anything because it is not a living entity. Sean

Explanation continued (if necessary):

Trustee and Executor of the Cestui Que Vie Trust on Record with MOJAG since Jan. 19th, 2017. This Tribunal does not have the luxury of pleading ignorance of documents the Minister of Justice has on file for the Beneficiary.

Adrienne Curran is hereby charged with fraud in the decision for referring to the Trustee as a 'self represented' litigant. It is not reasonable or correct to presume that a Juris Doctorate lawyer does not know that the Trustee Act of Ontario applies to all Trusts whenever Created and all Trustees whenever appointed. The Powers, Rights and Immunities of the Trust Instrument are in addition to those provided for by the Trustee Act of Ontario which has effect SUBJECT to the Instrument constituting the Trust.

Adrienne Curran is hereby charged with intentional gaslighting, provocational conduct intended to antagonize, and criminal malfeasance causing harm for trespass upon a Trust Instrument and for colluding with the Administrator to 'gaslight' the Trust and the serious nature of this Appeal.
