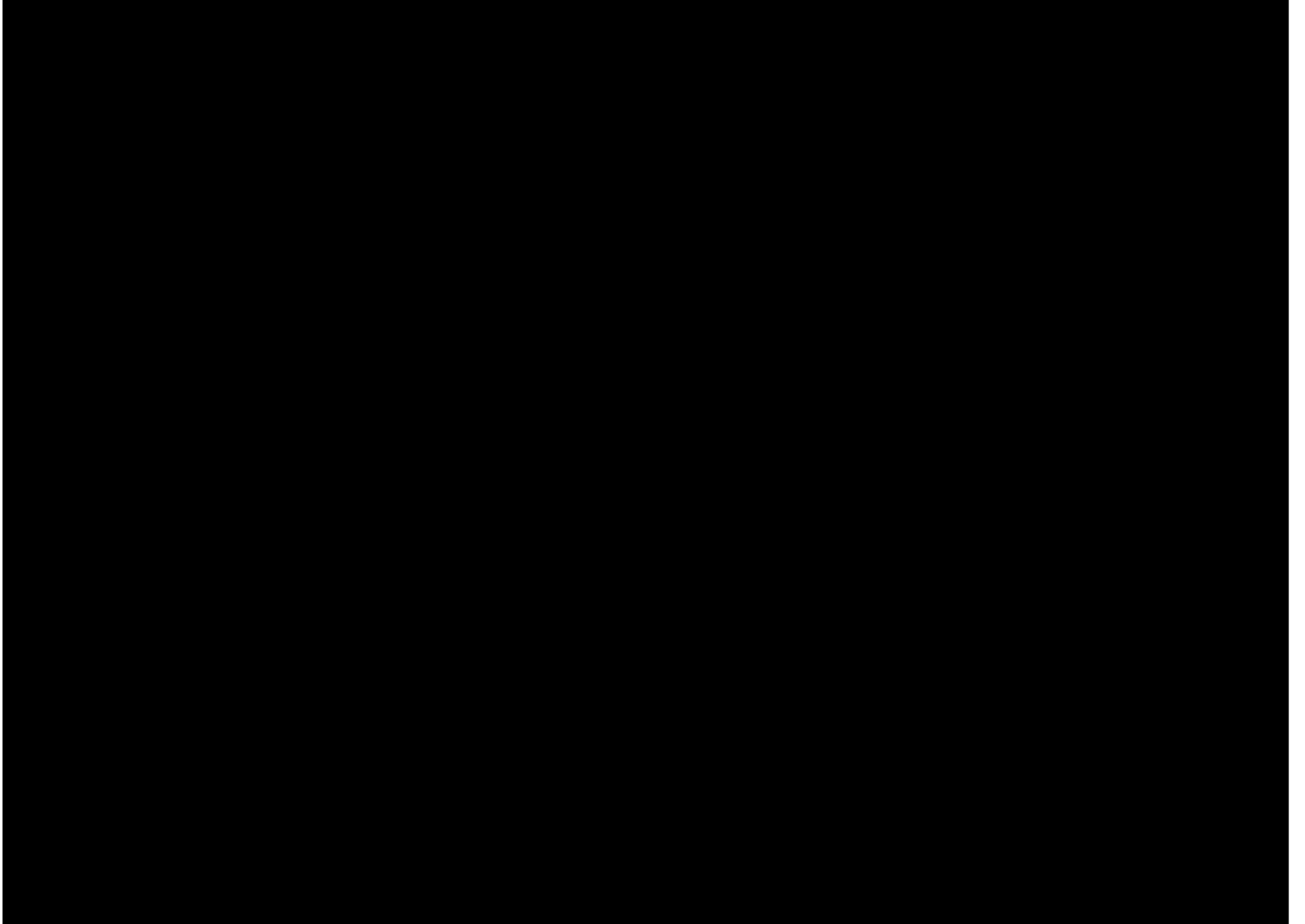

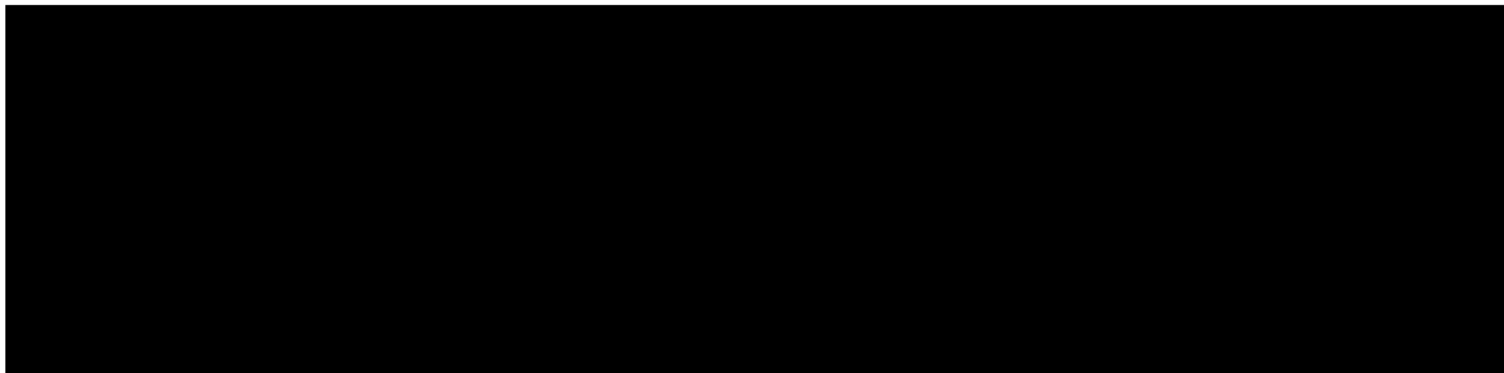

On Wednesday, 27 August 2025, I Cst. CRUICKSHANKS was on duty and assigned to general uniformed patrol in the West District of Ottawa.

At 1846 hrs, I engaged on a proactive policing call at 320 Via Chianti Grove in the Barhaven area of Ottawa in search of Sean VON DEHN (M) 1973-05-06 who was wanted on an unendorsed warrant in relation to this file. It should be noted that earlier in the day I attended and spoke to tenants of the building in the smoking area and learned that VON DEHN did still reside at this location.

At approximately 1950 hrs, I was approached by one of the tenants and informed that VON DEHN was out walking in the area.

I remained outside of the building in search of VON DEHN after familiarizing myself with his in house mug shot.

At 1905 hrs, VON DEHN emerged from a walking path north of the building and I approached him, identified myself and advised him that he was under arrest for an outstanding warrant for criminal harassment, and failing to appear. I took control of his arm and directed him to put his hands behind his back and felt his arms tense up before immediately informing him that if he resisted that he would be taken to the ground. He quickly complied and was placed in handcuffs without incident.

I subsequently escorted him to my cruiser parked on the south side of the building where he was searched incident to arrest. I removed cigarettes, lighter, some coins, a ring of keys, a travel coffee cup which he was carrying, and a smart watch from her person during the search and placed them in an evidence bag before placing him in the rear seat of my cruiser.

During this time he was exclaiming that I was a fraud, violating my oath, arresting him illegally, and many other rhetoric indicative of a sovereign citizen even though when asked he informed me that he wasn't a sovereign citizen though he did swear an oath to the King to uphold the constitution.

At 1907 hrs, I read VON DEHN his rights to counsel verbatim from my notebook. When asked if he understood, he replied "No I do not". I asked him which part of it he did not comprehend and he replied "I dont understand any". When asked if he understood if he had been arrested he replied "Yes" but argued the premise of it and was adamant that I was a fraud, and acting outside of my authority, and made mention to suing police.

At 1913 hrs, I read VON DEHN his charter caution from my notebook verbatim, and when asked if he understood, he replied "I'm done talking until I talk to a lawyer".

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Between 1918-1943 hrs, I transported VON DEHN to the Ottawa Police Temporary custody facility, 474 Elgin St.

Upon arrival I paraded him before the cell block NCO before he was searched by Special Constables.

AT 1958 hrs, I escorted him to counsel room 1311 and he looked at the list of lawyers before choosing Michael SPRATT.

At 2002 hrs, I placed VON DEHN in contact with SPRATT.

At 2013 hrs, I observed him to have completed the call. I asked VON DEHN if he was satisfied with his legal advice and he indicated that he was.

At 2014 hrs, VON DEHN was escorted to cell # 31.

At 2016 hrs, I contacted the CPIC section and executed his warrant.

This concludes my involvement.
